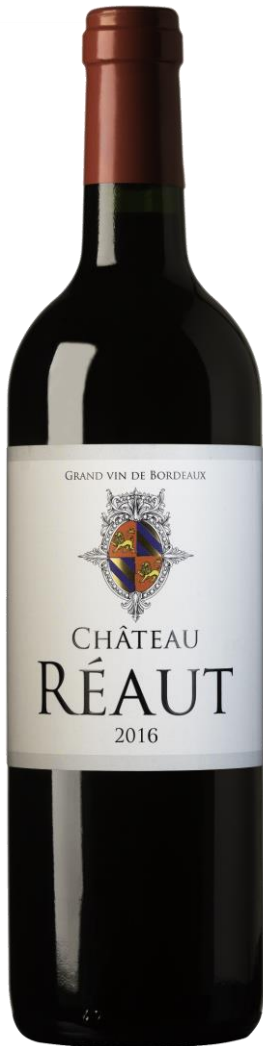




CHÂTEAU RÉAUT

Vintage 2016



Exceptionally located on a steep hill south oriented over the Garonne river and entirely replanted as Grand Cru by Maison ROEDERER Champagne, Château REAUT (26 ha in Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux) was purchased by Yannick EVENOU in 2012 with friends from Bordeaux and Burgundy.

More than 500 private investors from all over the world joined them to continue the initial project, proposing great quality wines with the value of sharing pleasure to produce and drink great wines.

Size : 26 ha

Location : Flanking the Garonne river in Rions village, 4 km from Cadillac town, South-East of Bordeaux city.

Topography : 18 hectares steep hill south orientated, from level 20 to level 90, and 8 hectares top of the hill deep gravels. Vineyard entirely replanted between 2004 and 2006.

Density : 6000 vines / hectare.

Varietals : Merlot 58%, Cabernet Sauvignon 37%, Cabernet Franc 5%.

Soils : Vineyards worked entirely.

Pruning : Double Guyot method, leaf thinning, green harvesting.

Harvest : Manual harvesting in small baskets.

Wine Making : Destemming, gentle extraction, slow fermentation (30 days).

Ageing: 16 months.

Environment: converting into High Environmental Value vineyard.

« Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2016 Reaut gives up warm black plums, crushed blackberries and cassis scents with hints of pencil lead, wild thyme, tar and smoked meats. Medium-bodied, the palate is packed with juicy black fruits and savory layers with a firm frame of grainy tannins and seamless freshness, finishing long. »
